Eligibility:

- Undergraduates enrolled in the School of Education for at least one year as of September 2008, are eligible. Undergraduates are eligible only for the **Burton Blatt Scholarship**.
- Graduate students matriculated in a School of Education program by September 2008, are eligible.
- Employees of Syracuse University are not eligible for any of these awards.
- Recipients of other major awards offered by or throughout the University (e.g., tuition bearing assistantships, traineeships or fellowships) cannot simultaneously hold one of these awards.
- As a condition of accepting an award, the recipient agrees to participate in activities intended to acknowledge the benefactors of their scholarship.

Evaluation Criteria:

The awards are made on a competitive basis. The Scholarship Committee places primary emphasis on proven and potential scholarship as documented by grades, test scores (GRE etc.), recommendations, scholarly activities, and other achievements. The following categories are used in evaluating applications: academic aptitude and achievement, personal statement, and recommendations. In addition, demonstrated financial need is considered by the School of Education in awarding the Burton Blatt Scholarship and the Dr. Barbara Irvine Shineman Scholarship. Minority preference is also considered in awarding the Burton Blatt Scholarship.

Financial Aid:

If you are applying for financial need based scholarships, you must file a FAFSA form (Free Application For Student Aid) if you have not already done so. You can find the form online at www.fasfa.ed.gov or by calling 1-800-433-3243. Please send all financial information to the address on the FAFSA form.
