*MS Program completion rate generally occurs within 2 years of a student's matriculation into the program. Students must meet all requirements for the master's degree within seven years from the time the student registers for the first course to be used in the master's degree program. If a student does not meet this requirement, the student may petition their school/college for reinstatement of credits that were completed outside the seven-year timeframe. The students referenced above all completed their program in two (2) years.

*PhD Program completion rate is determined by each student's matriculation date and indicates proportion of students who completed degree requirements within expected time to degree based upon the University's definition (PhD – 7 Years for full-time students). One student completed the program as a part-time student.
