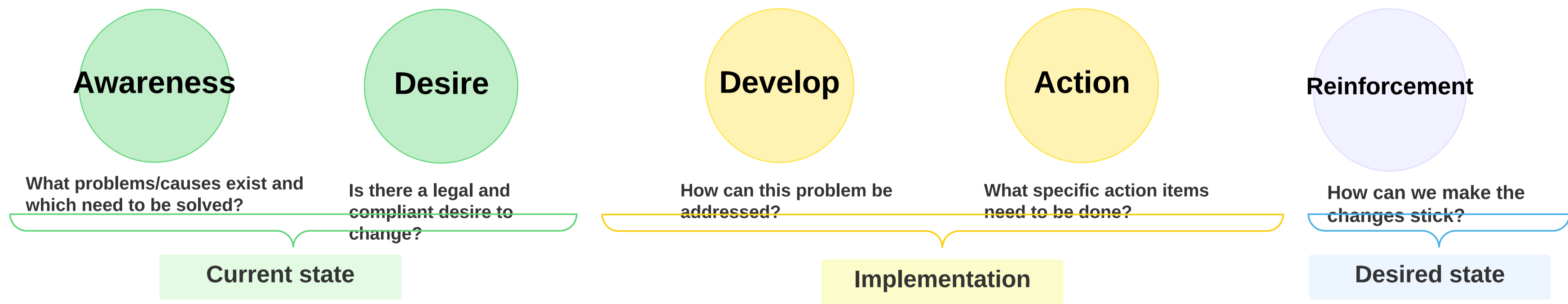
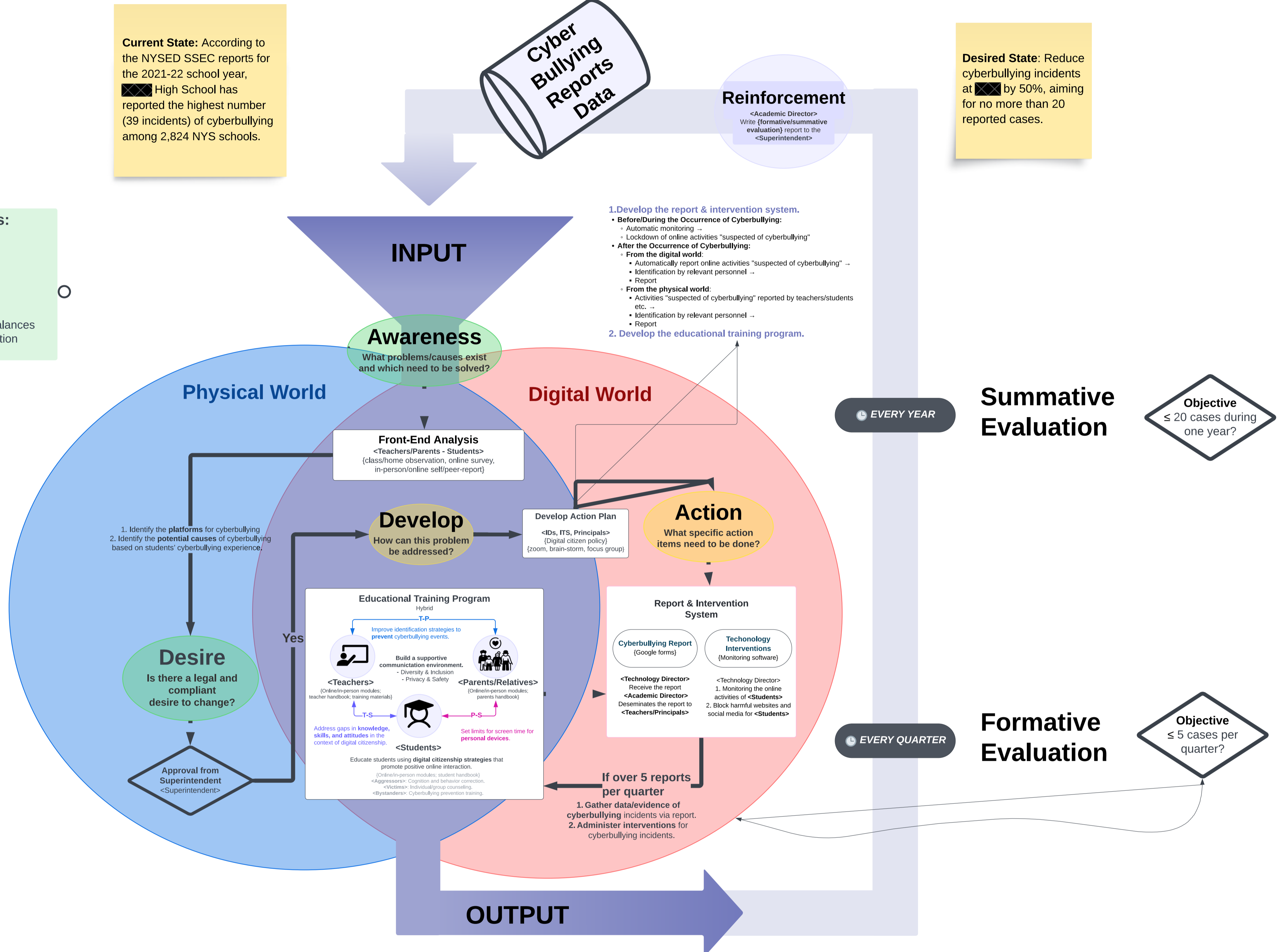
Box: activities

Current State: According to the NYSED SSEC reports for the 2021-22 school year, [redacted] High School has reported the highest number (39 incidents) of cyberbullying among 2,824 NYS schools.

Desired State: Reduce cyberbullying incidents at [redacted] by 50%, aiming for no more than 20 reported cases.
